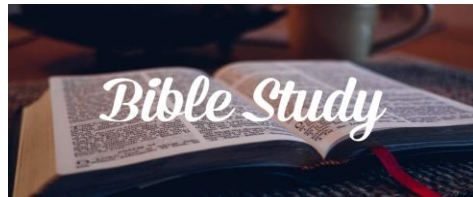

Camp Christian needs your help.....

I recently spent my 30 something week (oh heavens! Almost 40 something!!) at Camp Christian. I have been a camper, counselor, Asst Director and now a three-time Director of Chi Rho Camp Emmaus. My time at Camp Christian has been amazing, tiring and life-affirming. Some years better than others. My parents were campers, my children are now campers. I am seeing 2nd, 3rd, and even one 5th generation camper coming through the program. Ministers are called there...as in youth realize God has a purpose for them in the "Church". Youth (and adults) grow their faith there. It is truly a special place, "Holy Ground", set aside to worship and connect with God.

Through no fault of its own Camp Christian is in danger of closing. The Region took out a \$200,000+ mortgage on Camp. At the moment, the Region is only paying interest on the loan. Camp staff and friends would like to pay off the mortgage so that we can once again focus on the true purpose of Camp which is "To Build the Beloved Community". I have seen it happen over and over again my weeks at Camp. I have seen it carry over to life outside of camp. Friendships that last decades. Youth that go on to attend Seminary and to serve in churches.

If you have ever spent even just one happy hour at Camp Christian, maybe as a camper, counselor, parent picking up your child, or maybe dropping them off for a week, at a retreat or leadership event would you consider donating towards paying off the principle on the Camp Christian Mortgage? The Youth will also be doing some fundraising to help Camp.
